Olive Video Editor is an open-source, non-linear video editing software. It aims to provide users with a free and powerful video editing solution.

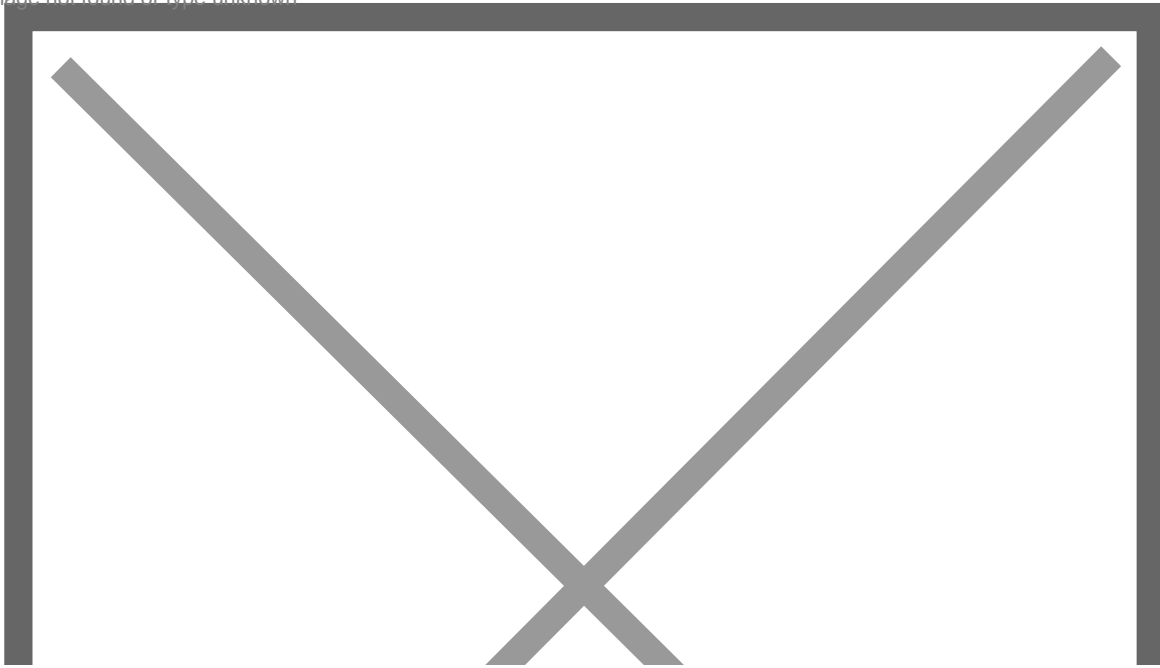
Features:
